

Safety Plans and Procedures

- Please bring a face mask and wear it for the entirety of your time on campus. This applies to all adults and to children 2 years of age and older. Only individuals who have been instructed not to wear a face covering by their medical provider are exempt from wearing one. We know that wearing a mask is not comfortable, but by doing so we can serve those around us by seeking to minimize airborne germs.
 - Please practice social distancing. We will be providing clear pathways to seats in and out of the sanctuary. Please honor a 6 feet space between you and others.
 - Be prepared for a verbal symptom screening upon entrance to the patio as well as a electronic temperature check. We will simply be asking if you or anyone in your family is experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms or has a fever.
 - Sanitize your hands before entering the facility. Staff will be providing hand sanitizer at the entrance of the foyer. Please clean your hands thoroughly and do your best to refrain from touching your face.
 - Family units may sit next to one another but must have 6 feet of distance on either side of the family unit.
 - If necessary to use the restroom please keep occupancy at a maximum of 4 and please wash your hands for at least 20 seconds before returning to the sanctuary.
 - At this point, we will only be using the upstairs of the facility. Please do not attempt to go downstairs either by way of the elevator or internal/external stairways. The only open entrance to the facility will be by way of the upper patio.
 - At the end of the service please follow the clearly marked pathways to out of the sanctuary.
