Proposing a New Local Outreach Ministry Idea

So you have a local outreach idea that you'd like to make a ministry of FCC? Well, we'd love to hear about it and help you make it happen! Simply follow these four steps:

1) Pray through the local ministry idea and evaluate it according to Scripture.

Once you think of outreach idea, it is wise to first seek God's will for the potential ministry. FCC believes that through prayer, Bible study, and the counsel of fellow believers, God is faithful to confirm, deny, and/or evolve your ministry idea until it is clear what action should be taken.

2) Gather like-minded individuals who would be interested in helping you with your ministry if it were put into action.

Ask around and find people who are passionate about your idea.

3) Commit the idea to a written proposal and outline the main goals and action items.

Before approaching the FCC Local Outreach Team with an idea, you should fill out this form and turn it into the church office or email us your idea using this template to fccloteam@gmail.com

3) Approach a FCC Local Outreach Team member with the written proposal for review.

Once you've committed your idea to writing, an FCC Local Outreach Team Member will review the idea, ask any clarifying questions, and then present the proposal to the team. It is the Local Outreach Team's current goal to meet once a month, but if your idea is time sensitive, please note this and we can strive to expedite the evaluation process.

4) Wait upon the decision of the team and then implement the decided plan of action.

Once the proposal has been presented before the Local Outreach Team, a decision will be made on whether the proposal will be put into action. You will be notified within a 48-hour period once a decision has been reached.
